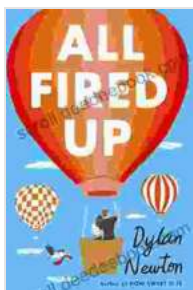

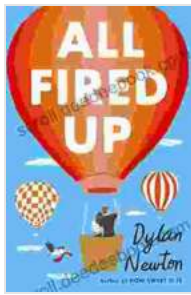

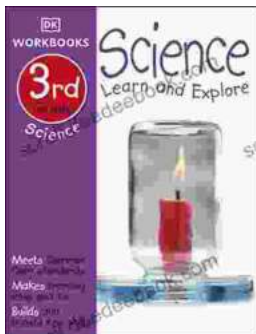

All Fired Up by Dylan Newton

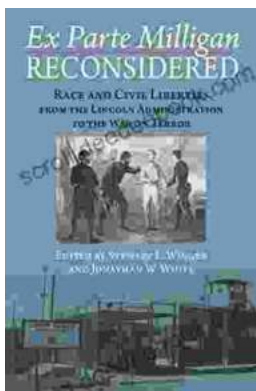
