

Bratfest At Tiffany is open from 11am to 7pm on Saturday, September 16th, and from 11am to 6pm on Sunday, September 17th.



- Sunglasses



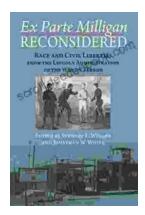
