



- By building a Nether portal. To build a Nether portal, you will need to place eight blocks of obsidian in a 4x4 square on the ground. Then, light the obsidian with a flint and steel. This will create a portal that will transport you to the Nether.
- By using a command block. You can use the following command to create a Nether portal:

/setblock x y z minecraft:nether_portal

Replace x, y, and z with the coordinates of the location where you want to place the portal.






