Pattern:**Base of the Hat:**

1. Make a Slip Knot and Chain (Ch) 4.
2. Slip Stitch (Sl St) in First Ch to Form a Ring.
3. Ch 2, Work 10 Single Crochets (Sc) into the Ring.
4. Sl St in the First Sc to Close the Round.
5. Repeat Round 3 for 7 Rounds, or Until the Base Measures Approximately 5 Inches in Diameter.

Side of the Hat:

1. In the Last Round of the Base, Work 2 Sc in Each Stitch Around.
2. Continue Working Sc in Each Stitch Around for 10 Rounds.

Crown of the Hat:

1. In the First Round of the Crown, Work 2 Sc in Every Third Stitch.
2. Continue Working Sc Decrease Rounds, Reducing the Number of Stitches by 8-10 Per Round.
3. Cut the Yarn Leaving a 6-Inch Tail, Pull It Through the Last Loop, and Tie a Knot to Secure.

Hole for Bun:

1. Using the Yarn Needle, Create a Hole in the Center of the Crown by Cutting the Strands of Yarn Between the Crown Stitches.
2. Make the Hole Big Enough to Fit Your Bun Comfortably.

Finishing:

1. Weave in All Loose Ends Using the Yarn Needle.
2. Enjoy Your Completed Messy Bun Hat!

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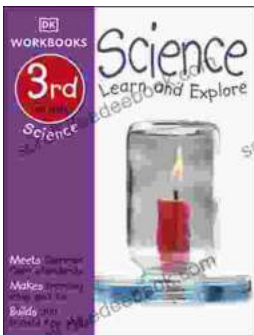
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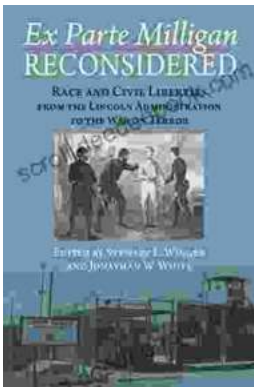
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
