Materials You'll Need

- Worsted weight yarn in seven colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet

- Crochet hook size H (5mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- (Optional) Pillow form for the Sun Pillow

Rainbow Blanket Pattern

Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in seven colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet
- Crochet hook size H (5mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Instructions

1. **Foundation Row:** Chain 140.
2. **Row 1:** Single crochet (sc) in the second chain from the hook and in each chain across. (139 sc)
3. **Row 2-8:** Repeat Row 1.
4. **Color Change Row 9 (Red):** Change to red yarn and sc in the first 20 stitches. Change to orange yarn and sc in the next 20 stitches. Repeat this pattern for the remaining colors, ending with violet yarn in the last 20 stitches. (139 sc)
5. **Row 10:** Sc in each stitch across, changing colors at the previous row's color changes. (139 sc)

6. **Rows 11-12:** Repeat Row 10.
7. **Color Change Row 13 (Orange):** Change to orange yarn and sc in the first 27 stitches. Change to yellow yarn and sc in the next 27 stitches. Repeat this pattern for the remaining colors, ending with red yarn in the last 27 stitches. (139 sc)
8. **Row 14:** Sc in each stitch across, changing colors at the previous row's color changes. (139 sc)
9. **Rows 15-16:** Repeat Row 14.
10. **Color Change Row 17 (Yellow):** Change to yellow yarn and sc in the first 34 stitches. Change to green yarn and sc in the next 34 stitches. Repeat this pattern for the remaining colors, ending with orange yarn in the last 34 stitches. (139 sc)
11. **Row 18:** Sc in each stitch across, changing colors at the previous row's color changes. (139 sc)
12. **Rows 19-20:** Repeat Row 18.
13. **Color Change Row 21 (Green):** Change to green yarn and sc in the first 41 stitches. Change to blue yarn and sc in the next 41 stitches. Repeat this pattern for the remaining colors, ending with yellow yarn in the last 41 stitches. (139 sc)
14. **Row 22:** Sc in each stitch across, changing colors at the previous row's color changes. (139 sc)
15. **Rows 23-24:** Repeat Row 22.
16. **Color Change Row 25 (Blue):** Change to blue yarn and sc in the first 48 stitches. Change to indigo yarn and sc in the next 48 stitches.

Repeat this pattern for the remaining colors, ending with green yarn in the last 48 stitches. (139 sc)

17. **Row 26:** Sc in each stitch across, changing colors at the previous row's color changes. (139 sc)
18. **Rows 27-28:** Repeat Row 26.
19. **Color Change Row 29 (Indigo):** Change to indigo yarn and sc in the first 55 stitches. Change to violet yarn and sc in the next 55 stitches. Repeat this pattern for the remaining colors, ending with blue yarn in the last 55 stitches. (139 sc)
20. **Row 30:** Sc in each stitch across, changing colors at the previous row's color changes. (139 sc)
21. **Rows 31-32:** Repeat Row 30.
22. **Border Row:** Change to black yarn and sc around the entire blanket, working 2 sc in each corner. (143 sc)

Sun Pillow Pattern

Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in yellow
- Crochet hook size H (5mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Instructions

1. **Magic Ring:** Make a magic ring with yellow yarn.

2. **Round 1:** Sc 10 times in the magic ring. (10 sc)
3. **Round 2:** 2 sc in each stitch around. (20 sc)
4. **Round 3:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next stitch.* Repeat * around. (30 sc)
5. **Round 4:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 2 stitches.* Repeat * around. (40 sc)
6. **Round 5:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 3 stitches.* Repeat * around. (50 sc)
7. **Round 6:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 4 stitches.* Repeat * around. (60 sc)
8. **Round 7:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 5 stitches.* Repeat * around. (70 sc)
9. **Round 8:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 6 stitches.* Repeat * around. (80 sc)
10. **Round 9:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 7 stitches.* Repeat * around. (90 sc)
11. **Round 10:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 8 stitches.* Repeat * around. (100 sc)
12. **Round 11:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 9 stitches.* Repeat * around. (110 sc)
13. **Round 12:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 10 stitches.* Repeat * around. (120 sc)
14. **Round 13:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 11 stitches.* Repeat * around. (130 sc)

15. **Round 14:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 12 stitches.* Repeat * around. (140 sc)
16. **Round 15:** *Sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next 1

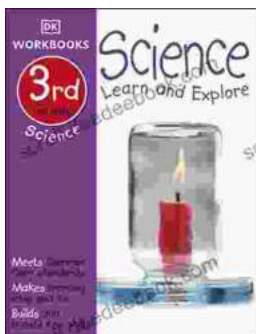

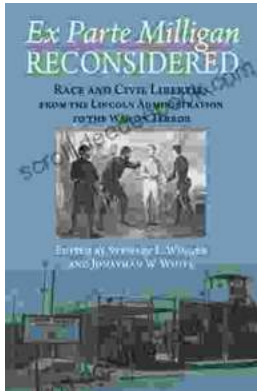
